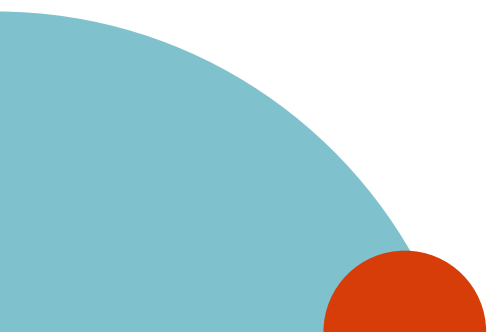
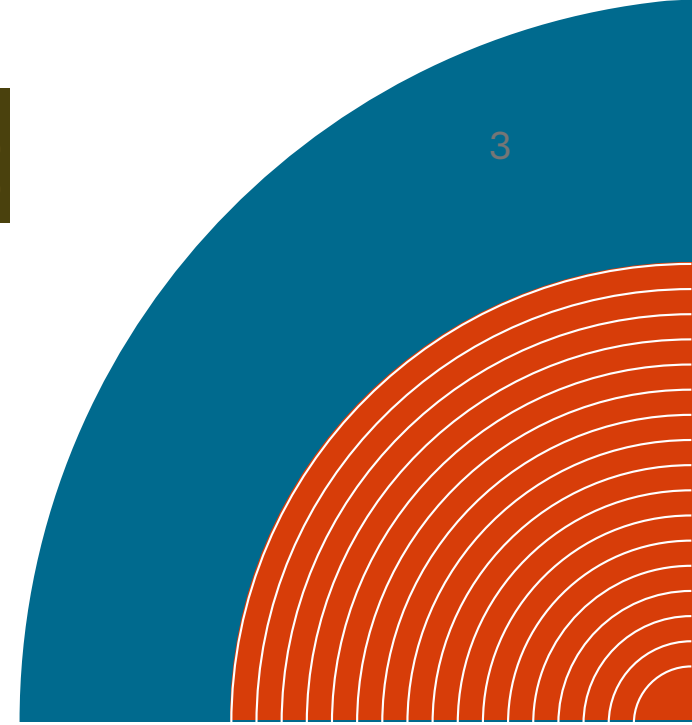

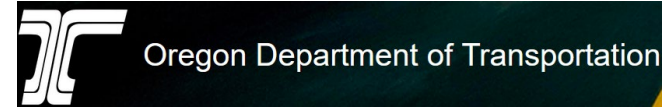

The State's motorcycle safety program provides statewide training, education and outreach for riders of all levels of experience and riding ability.

Founded in 1984, we currently train 10,000 students annually at 25-sites across Oregon.

We are an outreach program of OSU's College of Health. We collaborate with ODOT which provides direction, funding and support. Our funding comes from ODOT grants based in student tuitions, motorcycle endorsements and renewal fees.



Coverage on the Coast

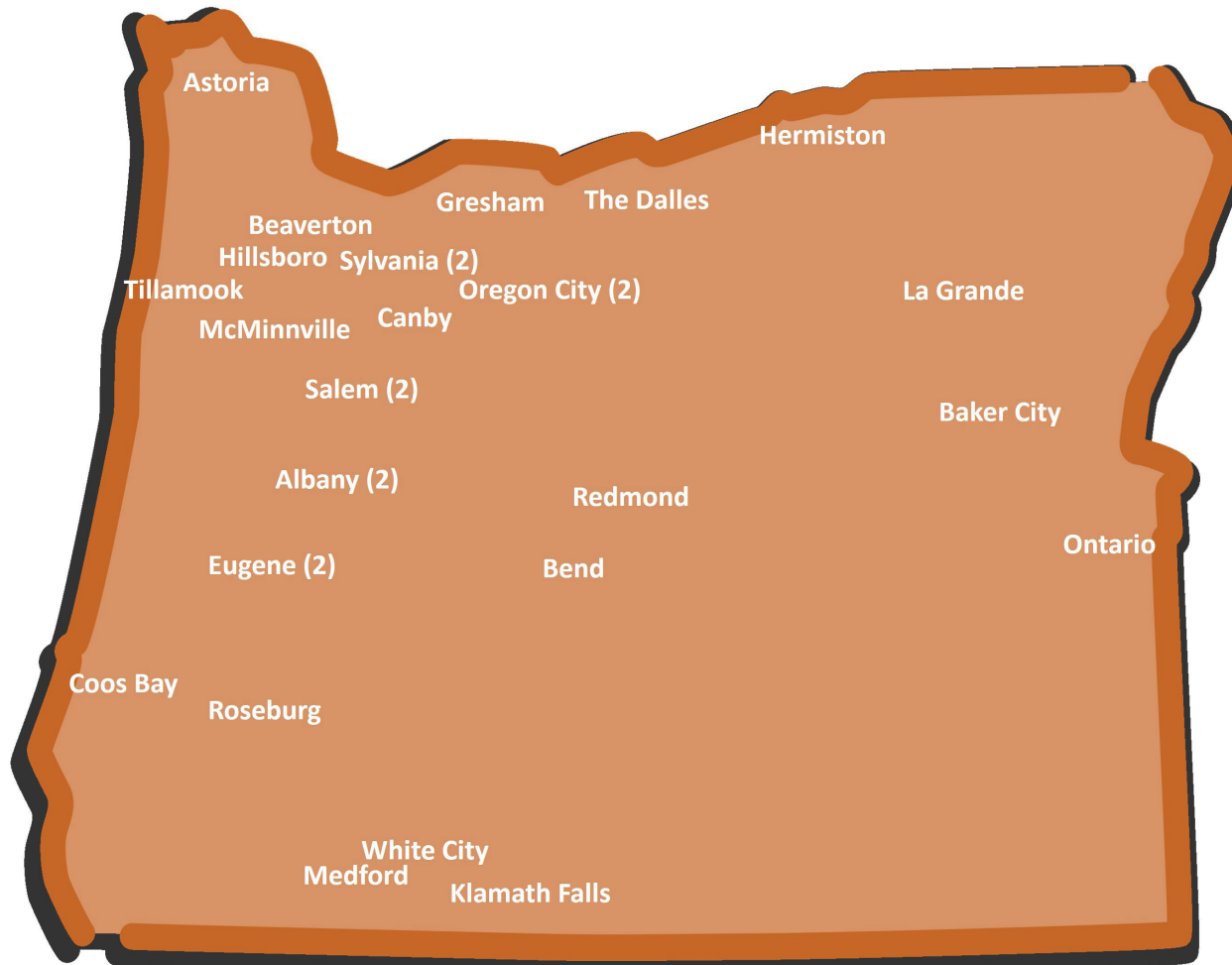
- Trained at Port of Astoria since 2008 - Port has asked Team Oregon to relocate
