Minutes of Meeting

March 26, 2019

Meeting called to order by Committee Chair Randall Henderson at 18:13 hrs at the Seaside City Hall.

Review of Minutes: No review of minutes as only page one was transmitted.

Infrastructure / Improvements: Project 2015: FAA final payment yet to be made. COAR Grant and Connect Oregon Grant, no information. Randall Henderson reports that AOPA regional airport support representative, Warren, could be of some help with funding bike shed. Other grants, Oregon Tourism Grant reports that request does not meet their criteria. Go Fund-Me account up to \$1425.00 for bike shed. Funds from all around the region being contributed, need a minimum of \$2500.00. Possibility of a local business to rent mopeds/electric bikes. Chad Sweet contacted Randall Henderson and indicated that the City of Gearhart could possibly contribute funds for the bike/multi purpose bldg.
